RULES 2012

CHAMPAGNE-ARDENNE YOUTH OPEN

ARTICLE 1 : Eligibility

The event is reserved for the following associations and delegations: regional associations, foreign national and regional associations and clubs.

Champagne-Ardenne Youth Open will be played in 8 single categories, from which the individual results will be taken for 2 team's ranking (Team's Challenges). No obligation to participate in Team's Challenge is required to participate in the individual events. One player can participate in his age category event and/or in the age category one level higher if possible.

ARTICLE 2 : Events

8 events for 4 age categories will be organized :

- 9 years old boys (born in 2003 or later)
- 9 years old girls (born in 2003 or later)
- 11 years old boys (born in 2001 or 2002)
- 11 years old girls (born in 2001 or 2002)
- 13 years old boys (born in 1999 or 2000)
- 13 years old girls (born in 1999 or 2000)
- 15 years old boys (born 1997 or 1998)
- 15 years old girls (born in 1997 or 1998)

The age categories are fixed according to ITTF age categories up to the dates of the event.

ARTICLE 3 : Entry fee

The **hospitality package** includs an entry fee of one event, for an additional event the additional fee of 8 euro will be required.

The entry fee **without any hospitality** package is 20 euros for the first event, any additional event will be charged with 10 euros

ARTICLE 4 : Entries

The preliminary and final entries have to be sent and confirmed individually or by the delegations. Each delegation may enter a maximum of 2 players in each event.

The list of participants with **the first and second name**, **date of birth and the ranking of every player according to the last ranking issue** has to be sent to the organization committee before 15/07 if possible, or at latest on 10/08.

ARTICLE 5 : Financial part

Travel and hospitality costs and entree fees are at the costs of the participating delegation. The official hospitality packages are proposed in the attached file.

ARTICLE 6 : Umpires

All the matches will be played with an official umpire or with another player acting as umpire? Each delegation of 4 and more players has to provide one umpire on a certain table according to the planning prepared in advance.

ARTICLE 7 : Referee

The referees team will be composed of a general commissioner of the organization, a main referee, a second main referee, an assistant and a referees manager.

In case of exceptionnal circumstances, the main referee may modify the present rules.

ARTICLE 8 : Jury d'appel

For each sportive responsibility, a jury can be formed. This jury will include the president of the league Champagne-Ardenne or its representative, the main referee and the general commissioner of the organization.

ARTICLE 9 : Playing systems

- 9.1 Due to the number of preliminary entries each event is limited by a number of 48 players.
- 9.2 First stage of each event will be played in the groups.
- 9.3 Second stage will be played in a progressive knock-out system up to determine a final ranking for each player.
- 9.4 At least 5 matches are guaranteed per player per one event.
- 9.5 The matches opposing french players will be approved and recorded on SPID.

ARTICLE 10 : Match system

Every event and every match of the events will be played best of 5 games.

ARTICLE 11 : Challenges

11.1 The Team's Challenge will take place in every tournament edition.

Every delegation can take part in the Team's Challenge with at least one player in each of 5 event's categories with at least two girls and two boys.

The winner of the Team's Challenge will be awarded with cash price money 500 EUR.

11.1.1 System

The ranking for that Challenge will be taken from the 5 best results in different events (two best girl results, two best boy results and the fifth result – boy or girl). Each of these 5 results will give the team the number of points equivalent to the place of the player in the event. There is a bonus of -1 point for the youngest category (under 9 years old).

Example: 1st in the category of 9 years old and younger = 0 points, 2nd in 2003 and younger = 1 point etc...

 1^{st} in the category of 11 yrs old/13 yrs old/15 yrs old = 1 point, 2nd = 2 points etc. The number of points obtained by a team is the total amount of points achieved by its 5 representatives.

The ranking is made by the amount of points achieved; the team with the least points will be the winner.

In case of an equal number of points the ranking will be ruled as followed:

a) first we will judge by the best individual result, followed by the second best individual

b) second we will reward to youngest player whose results count for the challenge ranking

11.2 The Girls Team's Challenge will take place in every tournament edition.

Every delegation can take part in the Girls Challenge with at least 4 girls participating in at least 2 categories.

The winner of the Team's Challenge will be awarded with cash price money 500 EUR.

11.2.1 System

The ranking for the Girls Challenge will be taken from the 4 best results in at least 2 different events.

Each of these 5 results will give the team the number of points equivalent to the place of the player in the event. There is a bonus of -1 point for the youngest category (under 9 years old). The number of points obtained by a team is the total amount of points achieved by its 4 repre-

sentatives. The ranking is made by the amount of points achieved; the team with the least points will be the winner.

In case of an equal number of points the ranking will be ruled as followed:

a) first we will judge by the best individual result, followed by the second best individual result, etc.

b) second we will reward to youngest player whose results count for the challenge ranking

11.3 The Challenge of the Delegation with the most representatives

Delegation with the most representatives will get a Trophy.

The delegations from the Champagne-Ardenne region cannot participate on this challenge.

Magnum of Champagne and Trophy of the city Charleville-Mézières.

ARTICLE 12 : Awards

The welcome package will be given to all members of delegations and all players.

Awards for the single events

 1^{st} places - cups, medals and gifts vouchers for the table tennis equipment 2^{nd} places - cups and medals 3^{rd} and 4^{th} places - medals

Awards for the team results

The winner of the Team's Challenge will get price money 500 EUR and Trophy. The winner of the Girls Team's Challenge will get price money 500 EUR , Trophy and flowers.

Delegation with the most representatives will get the Trophy of the city Charleville-Mézières.



1) Coming from the North, by Hirson:

Take the Ring (= Rocade) at the entrance to Charleville . Exit 12. Then follow signs "Préfecture", "Le Theux", "Gespunsart". At the traffic light, take left after the bridge under the railway.

2) Coming from the East, by Sedan (on the A203)

Leave the motorway at Junction 7 at Lumes and continue for 5 km along the regional D33 / D5. At the second traffic light, go straight.

3) Coming from the South, by Reims (on the A34)

Either you take the Ring (Rocade) to the left, following direction "Charleroi" and then exit 12 and route No. 1.

Either you take the Ring (Rocade) to the right, following direction "Sedan" then exit 7 and Route No. 2
